Mark Lynne is a retired Principal of Bolton Partners, a Baltimore actuarial, benefit, and consulting firm. He is a lifelong Baltimore area resident and a 1980 graduate of Loyola College with a bachelor's degree in economics.

Mark began his career as an underwriter at what was then BlueCross BlueShield of MD. He moved to consulting in 1988 with what was then Herget and Company. He became part owner of Bolton Partners in 2003 and president of the Health Care division in 2005,
