Dear members, I'd like to update you on our HSC activities during this COVID period. Last spring it was “easy” to close the Club, but it has been much more difficult to fully reopen. We initially made the decision to follow all the federal, state, and city governments’ rules and regulations. Our wonderful Chef Charlotte quickly established a system for supplying carryout meals that members could enjoy at home. Her program, which continues, has been a great success and kept us financially viable for the past year. Later in the summer, we were able to open for outdoor deck lunches for members with masks and ``spacing.’’ When indoor dining was again permitted, we opened with four, six, and now eight, or even nine, diners. We now are serving noon indoor meals three days per week--Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. We are eager to open on Tuesdays, and especially for Wednesday evening dinners once member demand increases. I appeal to you to come and enjoy the HSC facilities.
